



VTA Service Changes Beginning January 11, 2010

Changes to VTA Bus Routes Serving Valley Medical Center

Line 25: Alum Rock Transit Center to De Anza College via Valley Medical Center

Weekday 5:27 a.m. eastbound trip and 4:43 a.m. and 5:25 a.m. westbound trips will be discontinued. Weekday and weekend minor evening schedule adjustments will be made to coordinate with Lines 66 and 68. Sunday service will operate every 20 minutes to Valley Medical Center and every 40 minutes to De Anza College.

Line 61: Good Samaritan Hospital to Sierra & Piedmont

Weekday 5:34 a.m. northbound and 5:28 a.m. southbound trips will be discontinued. Minor schedule changes will be made. Weekend service will operate every 60 minutes (30 minute frequency on Bascom combined with Line 62).

Line 62: Good Samaritan Hospital to Sierra & Piedmont

Weekday 5:01 a.m. southbound trip will be discontinued. Minor weekday schedule changes will be made. Saturday 9:44 p.m. southbound trip will be discontinued. Weekend service will operate every 60 minutes over the entire line (30 minute frequency on Bascom combined with Line 61.) Extra Line 62 buses will also operate between Civic Center and Capitol & Berryessa from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. to provide 30 minute service.

Line 23: Alum Rock Transit Center to De Anza College via Stevens Creek

(Route 23 runs on nearby San Carlos Street) Weekday 5:04 a.m. eastbound and 5:59 a.m. westbound trips will be discontinued. Saturday 7:09 a.m. eastbound trip will be discontinued. Sunday 7:09 a.m. and 7:55 a.m. eastbound trips and 5:40 a.m. westbound trip will be discontinued.

VTA Service Changes Beginning January 11, 2010

Countywide changes to VTA Bus and Light Rail Service

Due to the decline in economic conditions, the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA) will implement routing and frequency service changes beginning January 11, 2010. After an extensive public input process VTA revised its original service reduction plan to include the public's comment and implement some of the changes noted below:

Route Changes

Line 33 and 47 combined to provide improved east-west service in Milpitas

Line 42 extended to Menard Drive

Line 81 will only operate between Cupertino Square and Santa Clara Transit Center on weekends

Discontinued Saturday Service

VTA Bus Lines 11 and 13

Discontinued Sunday Service

VTA Bus Lines 13, 42, 43, 45 and 46
