Santa Clara County Supervisor Liz Kniss to Hold Los Altos/Los Altos Hills Town Meeting June 27th

Meeting Is an Opportunity for Local Residents to Ask Questions of Supervisor Kniss and Representatives from County Departments

San Jose, CA: 5th District Supervisor Liz Kniss, representing Los Altos and Los Altos Hills on the Santa Clara County Board of Supervisors, will host her first “town hall” meeting for residents of Los Altos, Los Altos Hills and nearby unincorporated pockets of Santa Clara County from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. on Wednesday, June 27th in Los Altos.

The meeting, hosted by Supervisor Kniss, will be an opportunity for local residents to ask questions about County issues of Supervisor Kniss as well as representatives from many County departments, including the Department of Roads and Airports, Environmental Resources Agency, Parks & Recreation Department, County Fire District, California Highway Patrol, County Sheriff’s Office, Los Altos Garbage Company, County Solid Waste and others.

“It’s very important to me that I hear directly from the people of Los Altos, Los Altos Hills and nearby unincorporated County pockets about their key County issues and concerns,” said Supervisor Kniss. “Listening to my constituents – and being accessible to them – is one of my highest priorities as County Supervisor.”
