WHEREAS, the Rotary Club of Saratoga has beautified the city of Saratoga by planting over 240 trees, restoring Wildwood Park, installing newspaper kiosks, purchasing gateway signs, cleaning Highway 9, creating the Historical Museum and purchasing park equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Rotary Club of Saratoga has enhanced the city of Saratoga by presenting “Building Bridges,” a multicultural festival embracing many organizations and ethnicities, and providing support to groups such as Saratoga Sister City, Hakone Gardens and Villa Montalvo, and chairing the Saratoga parade and donating to the library and assisting the Chamber of Commerce with Celebrate Saratoga and the Witchy Walk; and
