**WHEREAS**, Community Services Agency offers case management for over 100 homeless individuals and families to assist them with housing, job training, and food; and

**WHEREAS**, Community Services Agency offers a comprehensive program including transportation, in-home services to assist with personal care and housekeeping and other specialized services to over 200 seniors to assist them in living independently; and

**WHEREAS**, Community Services Agency has a caring and dedicated staff, a board of directors and hundreds of community volunteers working together on behalf of those in need;
