I. Purpose

To establish a mechanism for system stakeholders to provide input to the Agency on the growth and management of the Santa Clara County Emergency Medical Services System.

II. Forums

Emergency Medical Services Committee (EMSCo.)

Comprised of a diverse cadre of representatives from all provider levels including field paramedics, EMT's, Health Advisory Commissioners, City Managers, public and private service providers, etc. The committee provides recommendations to the Agency and Health Advisory Commission. Meetings are held quarterly.

Prehospital Providers Advisory Committee

Comprised of representatives from each provider agency, hospitals, law enforcement, etc. The group focuses on the logistical and operational aspects of EMS. Meetings are held quarterly.

Medical Directors Advisory Committee

Comprised of various physician groups including South Bay Emergency Medical Directors Association, provider agency Medical Directors, etc. The group focuses on clinical care issues and integration of patient care resources. Meetings are held quarterly.

Multi-Casualty Incident Committee (MCI)

Comprised of a diverse cadre of emergency service responders who focus on the development and implementation of multi-casualty incident plans and procedures. Meetings held quarterly.

Clinical Practice Advisory Committee

Comprised of various system stakeholders including field personnel, physicians, nurses, etc. The committee provides recommendations related to the clinical aspects of the EMS System including protocols, orders, quality assurance and improvement, etc. Meetings held quarterly.
