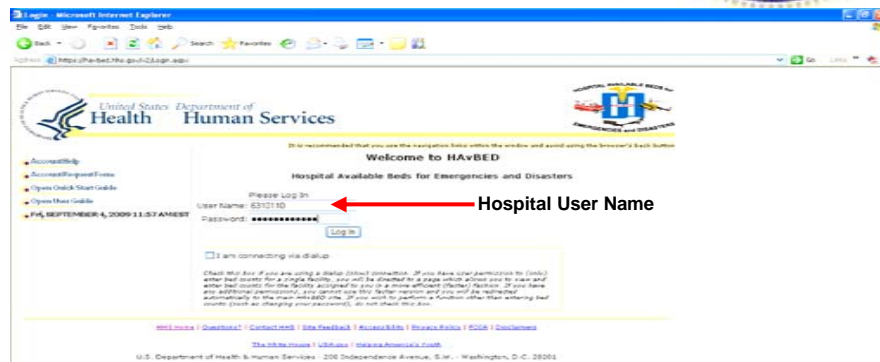
1. Open Internet Explorer and enter the web address:

- This will open the HAvBED login screen **Figure 1**.

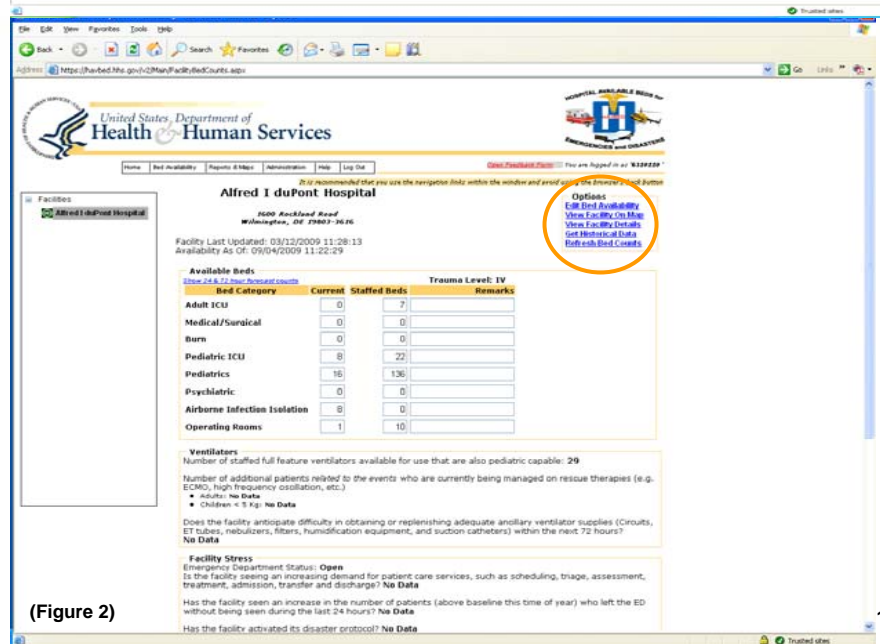
2. On the login screen enter your **User Name** ▶ **Password** ▶ click the **Login** button.

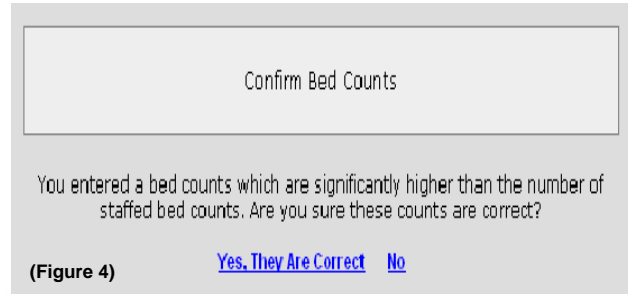
