Santa Clara County Public Health Department, is conducting the Behavioral Risk Factor Survey (BRFS) between the months of May and August 2009. A random sample of over 4,000 county residents will be selected for this telephone survey conducted in English and Spanish. The survey which is about 20-25 minutes long provides information on the personal health behaviors and health problems of residents in our county. Confidentiality is an important part of the survey protocol and individual data is never shared or released.

The data gathered is used by community leaders and planners to determine the health problems of county residents and what needs to be done to address these problems. We'd like to encourage everyone who is contacted for the survey to complete it. It's important to know the health problems and needs of the people in our county!!
