Medical Marijuana Identification Card Program (MMICP) in Santa Clara County

The Medical Marijuana Identification Card Program (Senate Bill 420) allows eligible patients and their primary caregivers to apply for and receive **identification cards** that may protect them against wrongful arrest and prosecution for use and possession of marijuana for medical purposes in California. However, SB 420 does not provide protection against Federal prosecution.

Patient Eligibility:

To qualify for a Medical Marijuana Identification Card (MMIC), patients must provide:

- Written documentation by their duly licensed physician warranting the use of medical marijuana and reside in the county where the application is submitted;
- Proof of residency such as a current and valid California motor vehicle registration, or a current rent or mortgage receipt or utility bill in patient's name bearing current address within the county;
- Government issued photo identification such as a current and valid California driver's license or identification card issued by the DMV bearing patient's name and current address; and
- Medi-Cal eligibility (if applicable) must be submitted in person at the time of appointment.

Caregiver Eligibility:

To qualify, caregivers must be designated by the patient. Caregivers must:

- Be at least 18 years of age;
- Have responsibility for the housing, health, or safety of patient; and
- Accompany the patient when applying for MMIC.

***All applicants MUST schedule an appointment by calling 408.792-5065.
Walk-in clients cannot be accommodated.***

Please complete an application prior to appointment. Applications may be downloaded from www.sccphd.org.

- Recommendations for Medical Marijuana use are not issued by the MMICP, only the card.
- The MMICP is not authorized to provide information on acquiring Medical Marijuana or related products.

Fees: A non-refundable processing fee made payable to the Santa Clara County Public Health Department for each MMIC issued. For Medi-Cal beneficiaries and their caregivers, fees will be half price. Please call for current price. ***Cash or money orders accepted only.***
