DATES	ACTIVITIES / DOCUMENTS
January 4** through February 10, 2010 (E - 158 to E - 118)	<u>SIGNATURES IN LIEU OF FILING FEE PERIOD</u> Judicial offices only.
January 4** through February 25, 2010 (E - 158 to E - 103)	<u>SIGNATURES IN LIEU OF FILING FEE PERIOD</u> All other offices for which there is a filing fee.
February 1 through February 10, 2010 (E - 127 to E - 118)	<u>DECLARATION OF INTENTION PERIOD</u> Judicial offices only. Incumbents must file during this period.
February 3, 2010 (E - 125)	<u>DUE DATE FOR RESOLUTIONS FOR GOVERNING BOARD ELECTIONS</u> Deadline for jurisdictions to submit resolutions for a governing board election.
February 11 through February 16, 2010** (E - 117 to E - 112)	<u>DECLARATION OF INTENTION EXTENSION PERIOD</u> If the incumbent has not filed a Declaration of Intention to succeed to the same office, then any other person, other than the incumbent, may file such a declaration during the extension period.
February 16, 2010** (E - 113)	<u>NOMINATIONS PERIOD OPENS</u> First day candidates may pick up nomination documents either at the district office or at the Office of the Registrar of Voters.
March 12, 2010 (E - 88)	<u>NOMINATION PERIOD CLOSES *</u> Deadline to file (in the Office of the Registrar of Voters only) all required nomination documents. <u>DUE DAY FOR MEASURE RESOLUTIONS AND TAX RATE STATEMENTS*</u> Deadline for jurisdictions to submit resolution calling for a measure election, and if applicable, tax rate statements.
March 13 through March 17, 2010 (E - 87 to E - 83)	<u>EXTENSION PERIOD *</u> If the incumbent fails to file a Declaration of Candidacy by March 12 th for his or her office, there will be a 5-calendar-day extension during which any candidate, other than the incumbent, may file for said office.

This calendar may not contain all of a candidate's or district's filing requirements. The Office of the Registrar of Voters is not open for filings on Saturday, Sunday or holidays.

* The legal 10-calendar-day public examination period in which a writ of mandate may be sought begins immediately following the filing deadline for submission of those documents. The writ of mandate request shall be filed no later than the end of the 10-calendar-day public examination period.

March 17, 2010 (E - 83)	<u>DUE DATE FOR ARGUMENTS*</u> Deadline set by the Registrar of Voters for submitting arguments in favor of and against a measure.
March 18, 2010 (E - 82)	<u>RANDOMIZED ALPHABET DRAWING</u> This day the Secretary of State and the local elections official will conduct a drawing of letters of the alphabet to determine the order in which candidates appear on the ballot.
March 22, 2010	<u>F.P.P.C. 1st PRE-ELECTION STATEMENT DUE</u> Deadline for financial disclosure report Form 460 covering the period of 1-1-2010 to 3-17-2010.
March 24, 2010 (E - 76)	<u>DUE DATE FOR REBUTTALS AND IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS*</u> Deadline set by the Registrar of Voters for submitting rebuttals to arguments in favor of and against a measure and impartial analysis.
April 12 through May 25, 2010 (E - 57 to E - 14)	<u>WRITE-IN CANDIDACY OPENS AND CLOSES</u> Time for write-in candidates to obtain and file write-in nomination documents in the Office of the Registrar of Voters.
May 10, 2010 (E - 29)	<u>FIRST DAY FOR MAILING OF VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS</u> First day of mailing of Vote by Mail ballots.
May 23 through June 7, 2010 (E - 16 to E - 1)	<u>LATE CONTRIBUTION/INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURES</u> Sums over \$1,000 to/from a single source must be reported within 24 hours. The Late Independent Expenditure report is required only for committees (not candidate committees) that make independent expenditures totaling \$1,000 or more to support or oppose a single candidate or a single ballot measure.
May 24, 2010 (E - 15)	<u>LAST DAY TO REGISTER TO VOTE FOR JUNE ELECTION</u> Deadline to register to be eligible to vote in the June 8, 2010 Election.
May 27, 2010 (E - 12)	<u>F.P.P.C. 2nd PRE-ELECTION STATEMENT DUE</u> Deadline for financial disclosure report Form 460 covering the period of 3-18-2010 to 5-22-2010.
June 1, 2010 (E - 7)	<u>LAST DAY TO REQUEST VOTE BY MAIL BALLOT BY MAIL</u> Deadline at 5:00 p.m. to submit a request for a Vote by Mail ballot to be mailed to voter.
JUNE 8, 2010	<u>ELECTION DAY</u> Polls are open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
July 6, 2010 (E + 28)	<u>OFFICIAL CANVASS OF VOTE</u> Registrar of Voters to certify election results by July 6, 2010.
