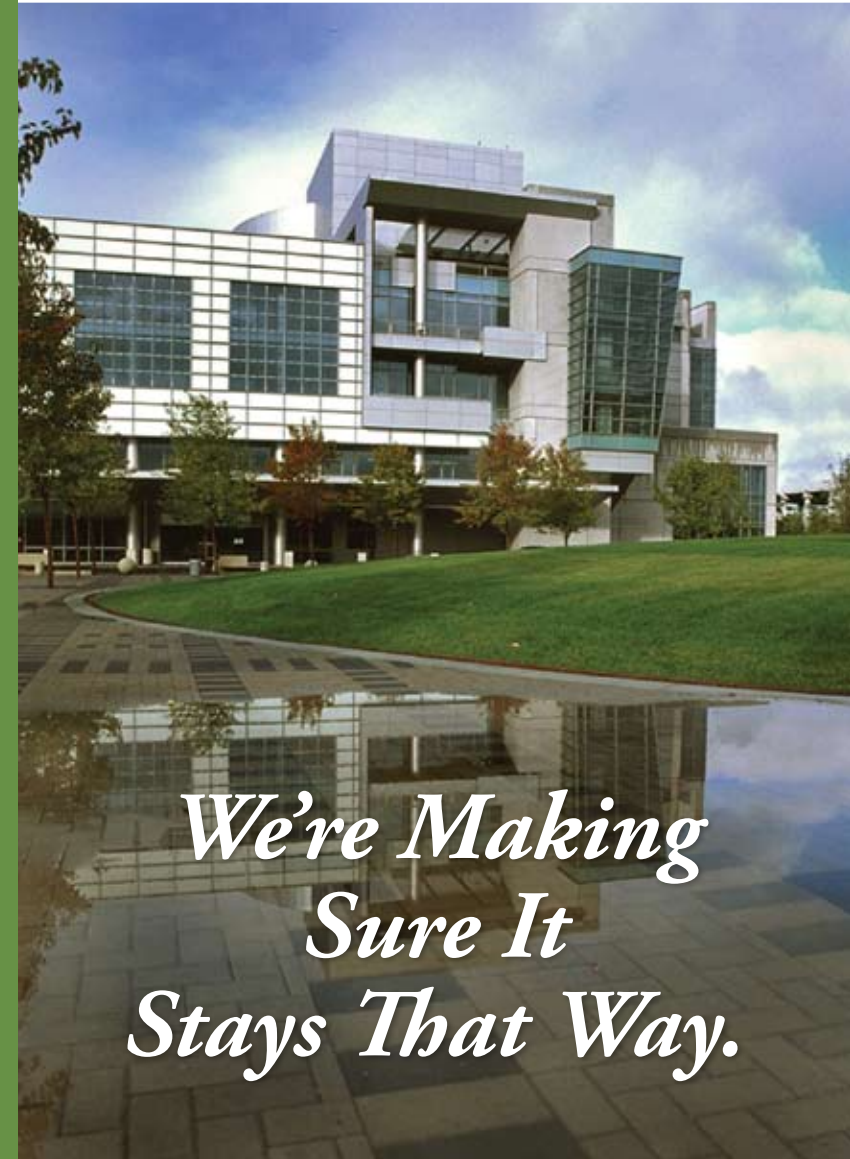

...when you or your family have a personal emergency

Valley Medical Center operates the highest level trauma center for adults and children and has received a Level 1 designation.

VMC also provides top-notch specialty services including a world-class rehabilitation center and a regional burn center.

The hospital is a certified cardiac and stroke center for Santa Clara County.



...in the event of a major disaster

Valley Medical Center is Santa Clara County's disaster response hub. VMC has developed 19 comprehensive disaster response plans for emergency situations such as natural disasters, pandemic flu, or a terrorist attack.



...for sick children and newborns
