

**FOURTH AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SANTA CLARA AND
AMERICAN MEDICAL RESPONSE-WEST FOR PRE-HOSPITAL
EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE AND TRANSPORTATION SERVICES**

The agreement between the County of Santa Clara ("County") and American Medical Response-West ("Contractor"), effective October 1, 2001, as amended by the first, second, and third amendments ("Agreement"), is hereby amended as set forth below.

1. The Agreement is extended for the final two year period in accordance with Section II.E of the Agreement.
2. Section IV.K.5.(a-e) of the Agreement is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

"Requests for exemptions shall be processed in accordance with Santa Clara County Prehospital Care Policy Reference #830: Exemption Review Committee Process Guide. This document has been attached as Exhibit I: and may be revised from time to time in accordance with Santa Clara County Prehospital Care Policy 109: Policy Development and Implementation."
3. All references to the Saratoga Fire Protection District shall now mean the Santa Clara County Fire Department.
4. This amendment is effective beginning July 1, 2009 and shall end on June 30, 2011.
5. Section 1A of the First Amendment to the Agreement is deleted in its entirety. The content of this item has been retained in Item 2 above (Santa Clara County Prehospital Care Policy Reference #830: Exemption Review Committee Process Guide).
6. This Fourth Amendment may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.


