SUBJECT: Contract Documents and Authorize to Bid the Communications Infrastructure Cabling for Valley Health Center at Milpitas

**RECOMMENDED ACTION**

Approve the Project, adopt plans and specifications, and authorize advertisement of Contract Documents for the Communications Infrastructure Cabling for Valley Health Center at Milpitas.

Opening of Bids:	Thursday, March 20, 2009 at 2:00 p.m., in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.
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**FISCAL IMPLICATIONS**

There is no impact on the General Fund as a result of this project. Funds from the sale of bonds authorized by the Board of Supervisors on February 8, 2005 have been transferred into SCVMC Capital Funds, Cost center 6846, Project 921-0912, Communications Infrastructure Cabling of Valley Health Center (VHC) at Milpitas. The estimated cost for the project is \$325,000.

### **REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION**

This project allows for the necessary construction and installation of the communication infrastructure and network cabling for the VHC at Milpitas. The contract documents are complete and ready for bid. Bids will be received and opened on March 20, 2009 or on a date stipulated in any further addenda by SCVHHS Facilities. The VHC at Milpitas will be ready to receive the telephone/data cabling effort in the spring of 2009. The timing of this process is necessary to avoid unnecessary delays or the added expense of working under more adverse conditions.

### **BACKGROUND**

Construction of the VHC at Milpitas was included in the Bond program approved by the Board of Supervisors on October 22, 2002. Funding for design of the health centers was approved by the Board in November 2002 and January 2003. The new 59,000 square feet health center will be located on County-owned land at 143 N Main St. in Milpitas.

The contract documents comply with the California Building Code (CBC), California

California Life Safety Code (CLSC), and California Fire Code (CFC) as specified in Title 24, California Administrative Code.

The contract documents are on file at the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.

### **CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION**

Failure to approve the recommended action will impact the timely communication infrastructure cabling of VHC at Milpitas.

### **STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL**

1) Advertise the project within one week of the Board approval in order to meet the mandatory pre-bid conference scheduled for March 3, 2009

2) Provide Keyboard notification to the Director, SCVHHS Facilities,
