

**RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE
COUNTY OF SANTA CLARA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA,
APPROVING CHANGING THE DATE FOR THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL
ELECTION FOR THE CITY OF GILROY FROM ODD-NUMBERED YEARS TO
EVEN-NUMBERED YEARS**

WHEREAS, the County of Santa Clara has received the request by Ordinance from the City of Gilroy, No. 2008-09, attached hereto, requesting that the date for the General Municipal Election be changed from odd-numbered years to even-numbered years; and

WHEREAS, California Elections Code Sections 1301 and 10403.5 allow cities to request consolidation of their election with the Statewide General Election; and

WHEREAS, The County of Santa Clara Registrar of Voters has determined that the change will not cause the ballot style, computer capacity, or voter equipment to be exceeded;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Clara, State of California, that the Registrar of Voters of the County of Santa Clara move the City's odd-year elections and consolidate them with the Statewide General Election in even-numbered years, commencing with the November 2, 2010 Statewide General Election.


