| <p>Agricultural Buildings</p>                            | <p>A structure designed and constructed to house farm implements, hay, grain, poultry, livestock or other horticultural products. This structure shall not be a place of human habitation or a place of employment where agricultural products are processed, treated or packaged, nor shall it be a place used by the public.</p> <p>Uses include: livestock shelters or buildings, including shade structures, milking barns; poultry buildings or shelters; barns; storage of equipment and machinery used exclusively in agriculture; horticultural structures, including detached production greenhouse and crop protection shelters; sheds; grain silos; and stables.</p> |
| <p>Unenclosed Structures<br/>("Open Parking Garage")</p> | <p>For natural ventilation purposes, the exterior sides of the structure shall have uniformly distributed openings on two or more sides. The area of such openings in exterior walls on a tier must be at least 20% of the total perimeter wall area of each tier. The aggregate length of the openings considered to provide natural ventilation shall constitute a minimum of 40% of the perimeter of the tier.</p>   |
