

## **Montague Expressway Pavement Rehabilitation Project (Phase 3) Federal Project Number ESPL-5937(132)**

This is the first project for the Santa Clara County Roads and Airport Department under the federal stimulus program created by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA).

The project is located on Montague Expressway at various locations:

- Between US-101 and Mission College Boulevard
- Between Plumeria Drive and I-880
- Between Capitol Avenue and Dempsey Road

The work consists of roadway excavation and repair of damaged pavement; grinding transverse and longitudinal pavement conforms; placing crack seal and filler; removing and reconstructing curb and gutter; constructing concrete curb in the median; adjusting manhole cover and utility boxes to grade, removing and placing thermoplastic striping, pavement markings and markers; placing rubberized asphalt concrete overlay; replacing detector loops, hand-holes and pull boxes.

On June 24, 2009, the Contract was awarded by the County Board of Supervisors to the responsive low bidder, Granite Construction Company of Watsonville, in the amount of \$2,819,059.00. The time limit for completion of work is 50 working days.
