



## NETWORK OF CARE FOR HEALTHY COMMUNITIES

The Network of Care for Healthy Communities an innovative, local-delivery Web portal, uses advanced Internet communication technology to enhance health decision-making by providing community stakeholders, families and individuals with understandable key information. This innovative program was developed by Trilogy Integrated Resources, in partnership with the Healthy Communities Institute. It is also part of the new national effort called the Community Health Data Initiative (CHDI), launched recently by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.

For individuals and families, the Network of Care for Healthy Communities provides a locally customized set of information, including:

- \* An easily searchable directory of all health services – federal, state and local.
- \* A state-of-the-art health Library and encyclopedia.
- \* A specialized, interactive, educational tool kit for Adding Fitness, Healthy Weight, Diabetes, and becoming Smoke Free.
- \* An advanced social networking platform.
- \* An HL7-registered Personal Health Record.
- \* Health related news from around the country.
- \* Direct feeds of content and educational programming from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.
- \* A legislative information and advocacy tool.
- \* And much more!

For decision makers and key community stakeholders, the Network of Care for Healthy Communities employs the most advanced program in the nation for integrating and locally customizing population health data for your own local area. The system integrates CHDI data into a Community Dashboard of more than 100 local health and quality-of-life indicators. The Network of Care then links this data with valuable content and applications. This system can be replicated to any county in the nation.

For example, users can view:

- \* Current county rates in more than 100 health related indicators.
- \* Trending and comparison of each indicator to national targets from Healthy People 2010 & 2020.
- \* Ranking compared to other counties using the National County Health Rankings metrics.
- \* Indexing “best practice” success stories from around the country to specific health issues, such as obesity, diabetes, cancer, the environment, bike paths and virtually every aspect of public health.

Local and state health directors and their community partners can access an integrated platform that brings the full spectrum of health information to a community or region.
