SERVICES WE OFFER

Our Housing Program provides free legal advice and representation on housing-related matters to low-income individuals in Santa Clara County. We can assist with:

- Defending eviction lawsuits
- Housing discrimination issues like reasonable accommodation requests for individuals with disabilities
- Enforcing the San Jose Tenant Protection Ordinance
- Legal Outreach and Support for renter organizing/campaigns
- Help with Housing Authority hearings
- Section 8 and other low-income housing issue like terminations and eligibility determinations
- Legal advice and information to tenants on notices and repairs/bad conditions
- Advice and information about foreclosure prevention
