Rights:

Rental Agreement
Privacy
Habitable living conditions
Physical safety

Responsibilities:

Complying with the rental agreement
Paying the correct amount of rent on a timely basis each month
Keeping the property clean and litter free

High Quality Homes, Healthy Residents, Safe Communities

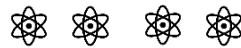

However, there are no standards or support for independent living homes.
