### **Statement from Supervisor Cortese on Santa Clara County's Move to Phase 2**

Santa Clara County is able to move forward with Phase 2 because of the cooperation and sacrifices of our residents, business owners, teachers, students, community leaders and healthcare workers. The County is ready to support the businesses now allowed to provide curbside retail, manufacturing and childcare as they prepare to reopen with the required safety measures to protect workers and the public from COVID-19.
