What Was Measured?

- The DA's Office was asked to do a more detailed analysis of its own juvenile records to provide more precision
- Factors analyzed:
 - *Compare Charged Cases to Charged Counts*
 - *Figure out demographics of charged population*
 - Zip Code, Gender, Race, Age
 - *Trends over time with specified charges*
- DA Office Data is limited to cases brought for charging decision
- Reports may not match arrest data because not all cases result in prosecution

Carjacking: PC 215


- Carjackings are not, by themselves, a 707(b) offense
- Charged carjackings were dramatically up in 2017 and again in 2018
 - *2018: (JAN-MAY)*
 - 34 minors charged
 - 43 counts charged




Age Analysis: 2017 vs Jan-May 2018



Carjacking: Racial Analysis (2017)





Carjacking: Gender Analysis (2017)

A Steady Increase in Car Jackings and Robberies







Zip Code Analysis: Robbery (2017)




Age Analysis: 2017 versus Jan-May 2018, 212.5(c)



Racial Analysis: 2017 versus Jan-May 2018, 212.5(c)



Gender Analysis: Robbery (2017)






Zip Code Analysis: Vehicle Theft (2017)



Age: Vehicle Theft (2017)




Race: Vehicle Theft (2017)






