The three Santa Clara County Family Justice Centers provide free, comprehensive services and support to survivors of domestic violence and sexual assault, all under one roof.

WHO WE SERVE

We help victims of any age, gender, sexual orientation, socioeconomic status, and ethnicity – including undocumented individuals – who have experienced or been threatened with physical, sexual, or emotional violence, controlling behavior, or other types of abuse.

OUR MISSION

Our goal is to ensure the safety, healing, and self-empowerment of survivors of domestic violence and sexual assault and their children.

OUR VISION

Together, we strive for a future where:

- All homes are safe and nurturing;
- All children and families grow to their full potential, free from the specter of violence, exploitation, and intimidation;
- All those who perpetuate violence are held accountable; and
- The human rights of all are respected, valued, and upheld.



FREE SERVICES

- Advocacy and counseling services for survivors of domestic violence and sexual assault;
- Immigration and domestic violence-related family court services, such as restraining orders, spousal support, and child custody;
- Referral to 24-hour emergency shelters;
- Physical & mental health services;
- Meetings with law enforcement investigators who specialize in domestic violence, stalking, and sexual assault;
- Meetings with attorneys from the District Attorney's Office; and
- Meetings with advocates from the Victim Services Unit of the District Attorney's Office.

SIGNS OF ABUSE

We can help if you experience any of the following:

- Physical harm;
- Threats of physical harm;
- Intimidation;
- Deprivation of food, sleep, or money;
- Forced sexual contact;
- Verbal threats and abuse;
- Restraint from leaving;
- Emotional abuse; or
- Financial abuse.
