

CHAPTER 5

Written and Spoken Comments on the Draft EIR, and Responses to Comments

5.1 Introduction

This chapter contains copies of the written comment letters (including emails) received from agencies, organizations and individuals, and copies of the public meeting transcripts; during the public review period on the Draft Environmental Impact Report (October 6, 2017 through February 2, 2018). Each letter received during this comment period is reproduced here in its entirety, with the exception of certain attachments and appendices to four comment letters (Comment Letters A-PAUSD1, O-CAARD, O-SCAS, and O-SCOPE) (in those instances, the subject attachments and appendices are included in their entirety in Appendix A-PAUSD1, Appendix O-CAARD, Appendix O-SCAS, and Appendix O-SCOPE, respectively, in this Response to Comments Document).

5.2 Comments and Responses

Each written comment letter is designated with commenter code in upper right-hand corner of the letter and arranged in alphabetical order. As discussed in Chapter 3 in this Response to Comments Document, the commenter code begins with a prefix indicating whether the commenter represents a public agency (A), an organization (O), an individual (I), or a speaker at the public meeting (PM). This is followed by a hyphen and the acronym of the agency or organization, or the individual's last name.

Within each written comment letter, individual comments are labeled with a number in the margin. Immediately following each comment letter is a corresponding individual response to each numbered comment.

Within each of the five public meeting transcripts (i.e., PM1 through PM5), individual speaker comments are labeled with the name of the speaker followed by the numbered comment of the speaker in the margin. Immediately following each public transcript is a corresponding individual response to each numbered comment.

Where responses have resulted in changes to the Draft EIR, the reader is referred to changes that appear in Chapter 2 of this Response to Comments Document. Where the individual response refers to the reader to one or more master responses, the reader is referred to the applicable master response(s) in Chapter 4 of this Response to Comments Document.
