As I have in the recent past, I am writing to you in an effort to keep you informed of upcoming meetings/events concerning proposed changes to the County of Santa Clara Williamson Act Program.

The County of Santa Clara Housing, Land Use, Environment and Transportation Committee (HLUET) will be considering proposed changes to the County's Williamson Act Program on November 29, 2005, at 2:00 p.m. in the Board of Supervisors Chambers, in the County Government Center, 70 W. Hedding Street, San Jose. HLUET is a committee of the Board of Supervisors consisting of two Board members who consider and advise the full Board of Supervisors on County housing, environment and transportation policy and program issues.

Following the 11/29/05 HLUET meeting, the Board of Supervisors will meet some time in early 2006 to consider the HLUET recommendations.

As some of you may be aware, the 11/29/05 HLUET meeting was rescheduled from an earlier November date. We very much regret any inconvenience you may have experienced, due to this date change.

County staff will be mailing you a notice of future meetings on this subject, once they are determined.
