Course Description:

This course prepares the student to begin the credentialing process as an Ambulance Strike Team Leader (ASTL). The Ambulance Strike Team Leader provides leadership and expertise to the ambulance strike team (AST) or the medical task force (MTF) members throughout a deployment.

Upon Completion of this Course:

The ASTL student will be qualified to begin the ASTL credentialing process with his or her local EMS Agency. This process consists of the establishment and then completion of an assigned ASTL task book.

The ASTL student will also qualify to be deployed as an ASTL “trainee” on actual deployments under the accompany and guidance of an accredited ASTL.
