Subject: Anticipated Designation/Permit Fee Increases – FY2020 (July 1, 2019)

The Santa Clara EMS Agency needs to update its fee schedule to conform to increasing costs and the County budget process. The County last increased its fees in July 2017 by a modest 5%. This increase did not capture the entire fee cost recovery based on a fee analysis. Due to this, we are required to raise fees again by 5% in FY20 in order to attempt to obtain full cost recovery.

The following revisions to the Santa Clara County Permit and Hospital Designation fees are scheduled to become effective on July 1, 2019.

Again, these changes are being made due to increasing costs, regulatory changes, and the lack of annual adjustments for consumer pricing. It has become evident there is a need to increase fees to cover costs related to the oversight of providers in the County of Santa Clara.

The EMS Agency understands that operating within the current economic environment is difficult and that providers are also experiencing increasing costs. The EMS Agency has resisted increasing these fees over the past several years; however it is now necessary to make appropriate adjustments.
