









Snapshot of the Supportive Housing System July 2018 – June 2019

System Inflow & Outflow

3,777 Homeless households requested housing assistance for the first time



1,993 Households were placed in housing, after enrolling in a shelter or housing program

Obtained Permanent Housing

71% were in permanent housing

(985 of 1,381) of clients who exited rapid rehousing programs

Permanent Housing Retention

95% remained stably housed for at least 12 months

(1,000 of 1,058) of clients served by a permanent supportive housing program
