

Project Description (including purpose and beneficiaries of project)		
<p>The Vessel Inspection Program for Zebra and Quagga Mussel Inspection is operated by the County of Santa Clara Parks and Recreation Department at various County-operated facilities to assist with coordinated Bay Area efforts to prevent the introduction of dreissenid mussels into local waterways. Invasive mussels spread easily by attaching themselves to boats, personal watercraft and related equipment. Invasive mussels pose a serious threat to water quality and water supply infrastructure. Agencies participating in the <i>Bay Area Regional Consortium Zebra and Quagga Mussel Coordinated Prevention Plan</i> agree to implement the vessel inspection and reservoir monitoring guidelines and procedures identified in the <i>Prevention Plan</i>.</p> <p>Authority to operate a Vessel Inspection Program for Zebra and Quagga Mussel Inspection was signed into law in October 2007 as a result of the passage of Assembly Bill (AB) 1683. AB 1683 authorized the Department of Fish &amp; Game to inspect and quarantine infected boats, close recreational facilities, and restrict access to certain lakes. AB 1683 also gave local water operators an option to control their own waterways by implementing a dreissenid mussel monitoring and prevention program.</p> <p>Staffed vessel inspection stations have been installed at five Santa Clara County reservoirs (Anderson, Calero, Coyote, Lexington and Stevens Creek). The stations consist of prefab 8'x14' structures on wheels. Stations are sited on existing pavement at appropriate distances away from boat launch areas, as defined by the best management practices of the <i>Prevention Plan</i>. No permanent utilities are provided to stations except at Anderson Reservoir. (Utilities at Anderson were provided by the Santa Clara Valley Water District as part of a service upgrade to their facilities located at the top of the dam. CEQA compliance for that action was covered under a separate environmental review). When necessary, portable restrooms are provided. Signage to implement the program was installed on existing facility structures (i.e. the side of the vessel inspection stations, at kiosks, or existing launch ramp gate.) Portable signs directing boaters to stations are also used.</p> <p>Implementation of the Vessel Inspection Program includes physical inspection by trained parks staff of all vessels intending to launch at a County-operated boating facility. Vessels that are wet-and-dry fail inspection, and are not permitted to launch. Vessels that have boated on a non-permissible water body are quarantined for 30 days and are not permitted to launch. Vessels that originate from a banned area are turned around at the park entrance or kiosk and never sent to the Vessel Inspection Station. Operation of the Vessel Inspection Program corresponds to the hours/days of operation of boating on the reservoir. Hours/days of operation vary seasonally.</p>

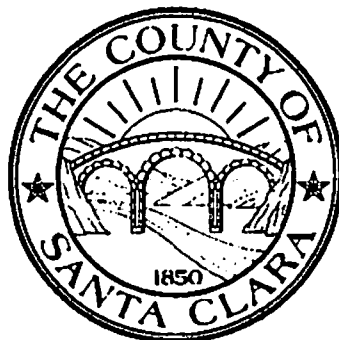
