<i>TBD if an Election is Called</i>	<u>CONTRIBUTION / INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURES</u> Sums of \$1,000 or more to/from a single source must be reported within 24 hours. The Independent Expenditure report is required only for committees (not candidate controlled) that make independent expenditures totaling \$1,000 or more to support or oppose a single ballot measure or a single candidate.
May 29, 2020 (E-88)	<u>¹DUE DATE FOR MEASURE RESOLUTIONS AND TAX RATE STATEMENTS</u> Deadline for jurisdictions to submit resolution calling for a measure election, and if applicable, tax rate statements. <u>DUE DATE FOR PROPONENTS TO WITHDRAW AN INITIATIVE</u> Deadline for proponents to withdraw an initiative that qualified for the ballot.
June 2, 2020 (E-84)	<u>¹DUE DATE FOR ARGUMENTS</u> Deadline set by the Registrar of Voters for submitting arguments in favor of and against a measure.
June 3, 2020 (E-83)	<u>LAST DAY TO REMOVE A LOCAL MEASURE FROM THE BALLOT</u> Deadline to remove a local measure from the ballot.
<u>June 3, 2020– June 12, 2020 (E-83 to E-74)</u>	<u>¹EXAMINATION PERIOD FOR ALL ARGUMENTS FILED</u> The elections official shall make the arguments available for public examination for a period of 10-calendar days immediately following the filing deadline for submission of those documents.
June 9, 2020 (E-77)	<u>¹DUE DATE FOR REBUTTALS AND IMPARTIAL ANALYSES</u> Deadline set by the Registrar of Voters for submitting rebuttals to arguments in favor of and against a measure and impartial analyses.
<u>June 10, 2020– June 19, 2020 (E-76 to E-67)</u>	<u>¹EXAMINATION PERIOD FOR ALL REBUTTALS FILED</u> The elections official shall make the rebuttal arguments available for public examination for a period of 10-calendar days immediately following the filing deadline for submission of those documents.
<u>June 22, 2020 (E-64)</u>	<u>¹FINAL PRINTING DEADLINE</u> Any petition for writ of mandate, including any appeals, should be resolved by this date so the Registrar of Voters can meet necessary election deadlines.

July 27, 2020 (E-29)	<u>FIRST DAY FOR MAILING OF VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS</u> First day of mailing of Vote by Mail ballots.
July 27, 2020– August 24, 2020 (E-29 to E-1)	<u>EARLY VOTING PERIOD AT THE ROV OFFICE</u> Early voting is available at the Registrar of Voters Office during normal business hours, Monday - Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., beginning 29 days before the election.
August 10, 2020 (E-15)	<u>LAST DAY TO REGISTER TO VOTE FOR AUGUST ELECTION</u> Deadline to register to be eligible to vote in the August 25, 2020 Election.
<i>TBD if an Election is Called</i>	<u>F.P.P.C. 2ND PRE-ELECTION STATEMENT DUE</u> Deadline for financial disclosure report Form 460 covering the period of ²⁷ 12/20 to 8/8/20.
August 18, 2020 (E-7)	<u>LAST DAY TO REQUEST VOTE BY MAIL BALLOT TO BE MAILED</u> Deadline at 5:00 p.m. to submit a request for a Vote by Mail ballot to be mailed to voter.
August 25, 2020 (E)	<u>ELECTION DAY</u> ROV Office is open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. for voting.
September 16, 2020 (E+22)	<u>LAST DAY ELECTIONS OFFICIAL TO NOTIFY VOTER OF VERIFICATION OF SIGNATURE</u> In the case of a voter whose signatures do not match, the elections official is required to notify the voter, at least 8 days before the certification of the election, of an opportunity to verify the voter's signature.
September 22, 2020 (E+28)	<u>SIGNATURE VERIFICATION DATE</u> Last day to turn in unsigned ballot or signature verification statements.
September 24, 2020 (E+30)	<u>OFFICIAL CANVASS OF VOTE</u> Registrar of Voters to certify election results by September 24, 2020.
