

The deadline for jurisdictions to file a resolution with our office, placing a measure question on the June 5, 2018 ballot, is March 9, 2018 at 5:00 p.m.

Measures are assigned letters on March 9, 2018 commencing at 5:00 p.m.

Arguments For or Against a County, School or Special District measure are filed with the Office of the Registrar of Voters. Arguments and their submission process must comply with all rules.

The deadlines for filing arguments for a County, School or Special District measure on the June 5, 2018 Ballot are as follows:

**Rebuttal Arguments to Arguments in Favor of or Against a Measure
March 20, 2018 at 5:00 p.m.**
