### BIG PUSH TO COLLECT MORE BALLOTS THIS WEEKEND IN SCC

**WHAT:** The Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters' Office will be open this weekend for Early Voting and to accept Vote by Mail Ballots for the November 2<sup>nd</sup> Gubernatorial General Election.

**WHEN:** Saturday, October 30<sup>th</sup> 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.  
Sunday, October 31<sup>st</sup> 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.  
For added convenience, there is a white, 24-hour drop-box located near the flagpole.

**WHERE:** Registrar of Voters' Office  
1555 Berger Drive, Building 2 (off Old Oakland Road)  
San Jose

**WHY:** The Registrar of Voters' Office has launched a "First in, First counted!" campaign in an effort to receive as many ballots as early as possible. Ballots received early will be included in the results posted at 8 p.m. on Election Night.

Friday, October 29<sup>th</sup> is the last day to safely mail a Vote by Mail ballot to ensure it is received by the Registrar of Voters' Office by 8 p.m., November 2<sup>nd</sup>. However, ballots received *this weekend* and up until Monday morning, November 1<sup>st</sup> are guaranteed to be counted *early* and included in the results posted on Election Night.

Weekend hours also make it convenient for voters who would like to cast their ballots early or are unable to make it to the polls on Election Day.
