## **SAMPLE BALLOT PAMPHLETS IN THE MAIL FOR THE NOVEMBER 3<sup>RD</sup> CONSOLIDATED ELECTIONS**

The Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters has begun mailing Sample Ballot and Voter Information Pamphlets for the November 3<sup>rd</sup> Consolidated Elections. The elections will only be in certain areas of the county and as such, ballots are being sent to over 216,000 voters or approximately one-fourth of the county's registered voters. This is not a countywide election.

The Sample Ballot Pamphlet is an important resource for voters to help prepare them for the election. It includes:

- Instructions for completing the official ballot
- Information about candidates and measures on the ballot
- A Vote By Mail Application
- The voter's assigned polling place location

Voters are encouraged to review the pamphlets carefully, mark their selections in the Sample Ballot pages located in the center of the pamphlet, and use them as a guide to complete the official ballot. Voters should bring the Sample Ballot with them to the polls to help the voting process move faster.

The Sample Ballot Pamphlet will be sent to all voters, in the areas where the elections will be held, who are registered by Monday, October 5<sup>th</sup>. Voters who register after that date will be sent a letter with their assigned polling place location.

The last day to register to vote in the November 3<sup>rd</sup> elections is Monday, October 19<sup>th</sup>.
