## **SAMPLE BALLOTS MAILED FOR PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION**

The Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters began mailing Sample Ballot and Voter Information Pamphlets today for the November 4, 2008 Presidential General Election.

The Sample Ballot pamphlet is an important resource for voters to help them prepare for the election. It includes:

- Instructions for completing the official ballot
- Information about candidates and measures on the ballot
- A Vote by Mail application
- The voter's assigned polling place location

Voters are encouraged to mark their selections on the sample ballot pages in the center of the pamphlet and use them as a guide to complete the official ballot.

The Sample Ballot pamphlet will be sent to all voters who are registered by October 6<sup>th</sup>. Voters who register after that date will be sent a letter with their assigned polling place location. The last day to register to vote in the November election is Monday, October 20<sup>th</sup>.

To make sure as many voters receive a Sample Ballot pamphlet as possible, the Registrar of Voters' Office will hold a voter registration event from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. at 1555 Berger Drive in San Jose. Registrar of Voters' staff will be on hand to answer questions about the election process and help Santa Clara County residents register to vote or update their registration. Voters who are already registered will also be able to cast their ballot during Early Voting hours, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., which begin on October 6<sup>th</sup>.

Santa Clara County provides Sample Ballots in English, Chinese, Spanish, Tagalog, and Vietnamese. Voters can update their language preference by calling toll-free (866) 430-VOTE [8683] or completing a Voter Action Request Form, available online at [www.sccvote.org](http://www.sccvote.org).
