POLLS OPEN FOR NOVEMBER 8 ELECTION

SANTA CLARA COUNTY, CALIF. – All 836 polling places in Santa Clara County are now open to registered voters for the November 8, 2016 Presidential General Election. The polling places, as well as the Voting Center located at the Registrar of Voters' Office, will be open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. today.

Voters who received ballots by mail may drop off their ballots at any Polling Place, Ballot Drop-Off Site or the Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters' Office prior to 8 p.m. tonight. A complete list of ballot drop-off locations and hours was included with the Vote by Mail ballot and may be found on the Registrar of Voters' website, sccvote.org.

Vote by Mail ballots that are returned by mail must be postmarked on or before Election Day and received by Monday, November 14. No postage is required to return ballots by mail.

Voters may locate their polling places by checking the back of their Sample Ballot and Voter Information Pamphlet, by visiting the Registrar of Voters' website at sccvote.org, by using the free [SCCVOTE mobile app](#) (which is available for download on Android and Apple devices) or by calling 1-866-430-VOTE (8683).
