## **SANTA CLARA COUNTY POLLS CLOSE FOR APRIL 7TH SPECIAL ELECTION IN SAN JOSE COUNCIL DISTRICT 4 6,942 Vote by Mail Ballots Tallied and Reported**

**SANTA CLARA COUNTY, CALIF.** – The Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters released the first election night results and reported that the polls have closed for the April 7<sup>th</sup>, 2015 City of San Jose Special Election in Council District 4.

The results released at 8:01 p.m. include 6,942 returned vote by mail ballots out of 28,921 vote by mail ballots issued.

Updates to the results will be posted at approximately 45 minute intervals and will continue updating until ballots arrive from all 26 polling places.
