SANTA CLARA COUNTY POLLS CLOSE FOR JUNE 23 SPECIAL RUN-OFF ELECTION IN SAN JOSE COUNCIL DISTRICT 4

8,242 Vote by Mail Ballots Tallied and Reported

SANTA CLARA COUNTY, CALIF. – The Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters released the first election night results and reported that the polls have closed for the June 23, 2015 City of San Jose Special Run-off Election in Council District 4.

The results released at 8:01 p.m. include 8,242 returned Vote by Mail ballots out of 29,427 Vote by Mail ballots issued.

The Registrar of Voters' Office will post updated results at approximate intervals of 45 minutes and will continue updating its results until all ballots have arrived. A new law took effect on January 1 that allows Vote by Mail ballots to be counted if they are postmarked on or before Election Day and arrive within three days thereafter. The Registrar of Voters is required to wait until Friday, June 26, to determine the exact number of outstanding Vote by Mail ballots before adding them to the final results tally.

This special run-off election includes a single contest to decide who will fill a vacancy on the San Jose City Council for District 4. Only registered voters who live in San Jose City Council District 4 were eligible to participate in the election.
