SANTA CLARA COUNTY POLLS OPEN FOR APRIL 7TH SPECIAL ELECTION IN SAN JOSE COUNCIL DISTRICT 4

SANTA CLARA COUNTY, CALIF. –All 26 polling places in San Jose, District 4, are now open to eligible voters for the April 7th, 2015 City of San Jose Special Election. Polling places opened at 7 a.m., today and will close at 8 p.m.

Voters who received ballots by mail may drop their ballots off at any polling place, Ballot Drop-Off Site, or at the Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters office, prior to 8 p.m., tonight. Voters may locate their polling places at sccvote.org, or on the back of the sample ballot and voter information pamphlet, or by calling 1-408-299-8683 (VOTE).

Election materials and bilingual assistance are available in Chinese, Hindi, Japanese, Khmer, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog, or Vietnamese. Call 1-408-299-8683 (VOTE) for assistance.
