SANTA CLARA COUNTY POLLS OPEN FOR JUNE 23 SPECIAL RUN-OFF ELECTION IN SAN JOSE COUNCIL DISTRICT 4

SANTA CLARA COUNTY, CALIF. – All 26 polling places in San Jose City Council District 4 are now open to eligible voters for the June 23, 2015 Special Run-off Election. The polls at our [26 Polling Places](#), as well as at our office, opened at 7 a.m. and will close at 8 p.m. tonight.

Voters who received ballots by mail may drop off their ballots at any Polling Place, Ballot Drop-Off Site, or at the Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters' Office prior to 8 p.m. tonight. A complete list of ballot drop-off locations and hours was included in the Vote by Mail ballot packet and may be found online at [June 23 Special Run-off Election Ballot Drop-Off Sites](#).

Voters may locate their polling places by checking the back of their sample ballot and voter information pamphlet, by visiting the Registrar of Voters' website at sccvote.org, or by using the free [SCCVOTE mobile app](#), which is available for Android and Apple devices, or calling our office at 1-866-430-VOTE (8683).

Election materials and bilingual assistance are available in Chinese, Hindi, Japanese, Khmer, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog, or Vietnamese. Call 1-408-299-8683 (VOTE) for assistance.

Voters who drop off their completed Vote by Mail ballots must remember to sign their return envelope, as their signature must be compared to their voter registration form to confirm their identity.

This special run-off election includes a single contest to decide who will fill a vacancy on the San Jose City Council for District 4. Only registered voters who live in San Jose City Council District 4 are eligible to participate in the election.
