TODAY IS ELECTION DAY FOR ALL MAIL BALLOT ELECTION IN LOS GATOS-SARATOGA JOINT UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT

SANTA CLARA COUNTY, CALIF. –Today is Election Day in the Special All Mail Ballot Election in the Los Gatos-Saratoga Joint Union High School District.

All voters should have received ballots by mail and if your ballot is not already returned you should drop ballots off at a Ballot Drop-Off Site, or at the Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters' Office, prior to 8:00 p.m. tonight.

Election materials and bilingual assistance are available in Chinese, Hindi, Japanese, Khmer, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog, or Vietnamese; call 1-408-299-8683 (VOTE) for assistance.

Updates to the results will be posted at approximately 8:05 p.m. tonight and will continue to update prior to 5:00 p.m. tomorrow.

Voters who prefer to cast their ballots in person can vote at the Registrar of Voters' Office. The Registrar's Office will be open for voting from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. today only.

Returning Ballots

Ballots that are returned in person must be received by 8:00 p.m. today. Ballots returned by mail must be postmarked today and must be received by Friday, May 6 (three days after the election).

For added convenience, the Registrar of Voters' Office has ballot drop boxes at city halls available during normal business hours. There is also a drop box inside the County Government Center at 70 West Hedding Street and 24 hour drop boxes at the Saratoga Library and in the parking lot of the Registrar of Voters' Office.
