FORMAL NOTICE OF PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION
MARCH 3, 2020**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on March 3, 2020, a Presidential Primary Election will be held in the County of Santa Clara and the offices for which candidates may be nominated included below.

A number of documents must be filed at the local county elections office, and for some offices also at the Secretary of State's office, in order to qualify as a candidate for the statewide ballot.

Also, pursuant to Elections Code Section 10400, such election may be either completely or partially consolidated. Offices to be Elected are:

President of the United States

Term of Office: 4 years

State of California Offices:

United States Representatives in Congress for Districts 17th, 18th, 19th, 20th

Term of Office: 2 years

State Senate Districts 13th, 15th, and 17th

Term of Office: 4 years

State Assembly Member Districts 24th, 25th, 27th, 28th, 29th, 30th

Term of Office: 2 years

County of Santa Clara Offices:

Judge of the Superior Court, Office Nos. 1 – 29

Term of Office: 6 years

County Supervisor, Districts 2, 3, & 5

Term of Office: 4 years

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the Signature-in-Lieu of Filing Fee period for all offices which have a filing fee opens on September 12, 2019, and runs through November 6, 2019.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the filing period for the Declaration of Intention (Judicial offices only) opens on October 28, 2019, and runs through November 6, 2019; incumbents must file during this period. For those judicial offices in which the incumbent did not file, the extension period to file the Declaration of Intention runs from November 7, through November 12, 2019.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the nomination documents for all State and County Offices, including a Declaration of Candidacy, for eligible candidates desiring to file for elective office may be obtained from the Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters' Office, 1555 Berger Drive, Building #2, San Jose, California 95112. The nomination documents will be available beginning on Tuesday, November 12, 2019, and must be filed with the Registrar of Voters' Office no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, December 6, 2019.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that all active registered voters will automatically be mailed a Vote-by-Mail ballot package beginning on February 3, 2020; the Vote Centers for said election will be open starting on February 22, 2020, through March 2, 2020, for varying hours of operations. Please see our List of Vote Centers hours of operation posted on our website at <https://www.sccvote.org/>. The Vote Centers will be open on Election Day, March 3, 2020, from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. All ballots cast in said election will be counted centrally at the Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters' Office, 1555 Berger Drive, Building #2, San Jose, California 95112.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to Elections Code Section 15101(b), Vote-by-Mail ballots will be opened and processed for counting beginning February 18, 2020, at the Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters' Office, 1555 Berger Drive, Building #2, San Jose, California 95112.
