FORMAL NOTICE OF SPECIAL RECALL ELECTION
JUNE 5, 2018**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on June 5, 2018, a Special Recall Election will be held in the County of Santa Clara for the office of Judge Aaron Persky, Judge of the Superior Court at which candidates may be nominated for the unexpired term of his office, should the officer be recalled.

Also, pursuant to Elections Code Section 10400, such election shall be consolidated with the Statewide Primary Election also to be held on June 5, 2018.

The Recall Election will contain two separate contests; the first contest to consist of the question:

“Shall Aaron Persky be recalled (removed) from the office of
Judge of the Superior Court?” - Yes or No.

The names of the candidates nominated to succeed the officer sought to be recalled shall appear under the recall question.

Qualifications: The candidate must be a registered voter, and a member of the State Bar for ten years or have served as a judge of a California court of record for ten years immediately preceding the election.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the nomination documents for eligible candidates desiring to file for this elective office may be obtained from the Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters' Office, 1555 Berger Drive, Building #2, San Jose, California, 95112. The candidates may begin to obtain official forms beginning on February 7, 2018. All forms must be filed with the Registrar of Voters at the above noted address no later than 5:00 p.m. on March 22, 2108.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the polls for said election will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. All ballots cast in said election will be counted centrally at the Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters' Office, 1555 Berger Drive, Building #2, San Jose, California.
