Subject: [EXTERNAL] Comment on Inmar Intelligence + LifeInCheck Proposed Stewardship Plan - May 23, 2020

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on Inmar Intelligence's proposed Safe Drug Disposal Stewardship Plan for the County of Santa Clara, dated May 23, 2020. The County may wish to request more specificity in the Plan on how Inmar will coordinate other Plan Operators on the single system of promotion for all Stewardship Plans. For instance, it is unclear whether the Inmar's LifeInCheck™ Consumer Drug Take-Back website is intended to be the single website for all Stewardship Plans, or whether the single website will direct users to the Inmar's LifeInCheck™ Consumer Drug Take-Back website as relevant. The County may also wish to request that the Plan specify whether Inmar intends to prioritize establishing new drop-off sites locations, as opposed to establishing new kiosks in drop-off sites already established under an existing approved Plan.
