SUBJECT: Final Notice of Determination – Approval of MED-Project, LLC’s proposed revised Stewardship Plan dated March 4, 2019

DETERMINATION:

Pursuant to Division B11, Chapter XX of the County of Santa Clara Ordinance Code (Ordinance No. NS-517.91, “Ordinance”), and regulations adopted by the Director pursuant to Section B11-552(a) of the Ordinance (“Regulations”), the Director of the County of Santa Clara (“County”) Consumer and Environmental Protection Agency (“Director”) approves the Stewardship Plan, “A Product Stewardship Plan For Unwanted Medicine from Households” (“Plan”) submitted March 4, 2019 by MED-Project, LLC (“MED-Project”), subject to the following incorporated conditions of final approval:

All conditions set forth in the Director’s March 20, 2017 Notice of Determination (“the March 20, 2017 NOD Conditions”), subject to any exceptions or extensions set forth in the Director’s April 17, 2017 letter to MED-Project (“Director’s April 17, 2017 Letter”); all conditions set forth in the Director’s July 11, 2017 Notice of Determination (“the July 11, 2017 NOD Conditions”), subject to any exceptions or extensions set forth in the Director’s September 29, 2017 letter to MED-Project (“Director’s September 29, 2017 Letter”); all conditions set forth in the County’s April 13, 2018 letter to MED-Project requesting clarification to proposed Plan dated January 31, 2018; all conditions set forth in the Director’s October 26, 2018 Final Notice of Determination and MED-Project’s representations and responses to those conditions as discussed in MED-Project’s November 21, 2018 letter sent in response to the October 26, 2018 Final Notice of

Determination, and all conditions set forth in the February 22, 2019 email from William Grimes (County) to Dr. Victoria Travis (MED-Project).

With the aforementioned conditions incorporated, the March 4, 2019 Plan is approved and shall be implemented as the operating plan for compliance with the Ordinance by those Participating Producers identified in Appendix A of the Plan (as updated by MED-Project subject to written approval by the Director pursuant to County of Santa Clara Ordinance Code Section B11-544(b)) until such time as a successor proposed Plan is deemed accepted by the Director.

The March 4, 2019 Plan will be posted on the County website with an active date of July 29, 2019. All MED-Project deliverables in the plan indexed to the approval date shall recognize the July 29, 2019 date.
