### **DETAILS:**

On November 8th 2019 at approximately 5:22 AM, deputies responded to a report of an in-progress burglary at a residence on Via Portofino in the City of Cupertino.

The resident called 9-1-1 when she heard what sounded like someone breaking into her house. The resident was an adult female who was home alone at the time. She hid in an upstairs bathroom while on the phone with dispatchers.

At approximately 5:29 AM, deputies arrived on scene and immediately set up a perimeter around the residence. Deputies saw a male subject running eastbound from the neighborhood towards N. De Anza Boulevard. With the assistance of Santa Clara Police Department's K9 Unit, deputies attempted to track the suspect's location. After a thorough search, no suspect was located and the victim was unharmed. The suspect was described as a male wearing a dark-colored, long sleeve shirt and dark pants.
